All great books and definitive sources, all containing great illustrations and informative texts, but all need flipping backwards and forwards to find the text that matches the illustrations.Some serious work has gone into the selection of pieces here when the majority of people would have gone for the big name factories. Rathbone, Keeling, the Pattern Book Factory and minor potters are all well represented to produce a book with wide ranging scope.Items fom Miller/Berthoud represent a significant proportion of the items illustrated which is no bad thing considering their Directory and Anthology of teapots.Five hundred specimens are present and for teapot lovers and china enthusiasts this is the book to own after the Miller/Berthoud volumes mentioned earlier.
