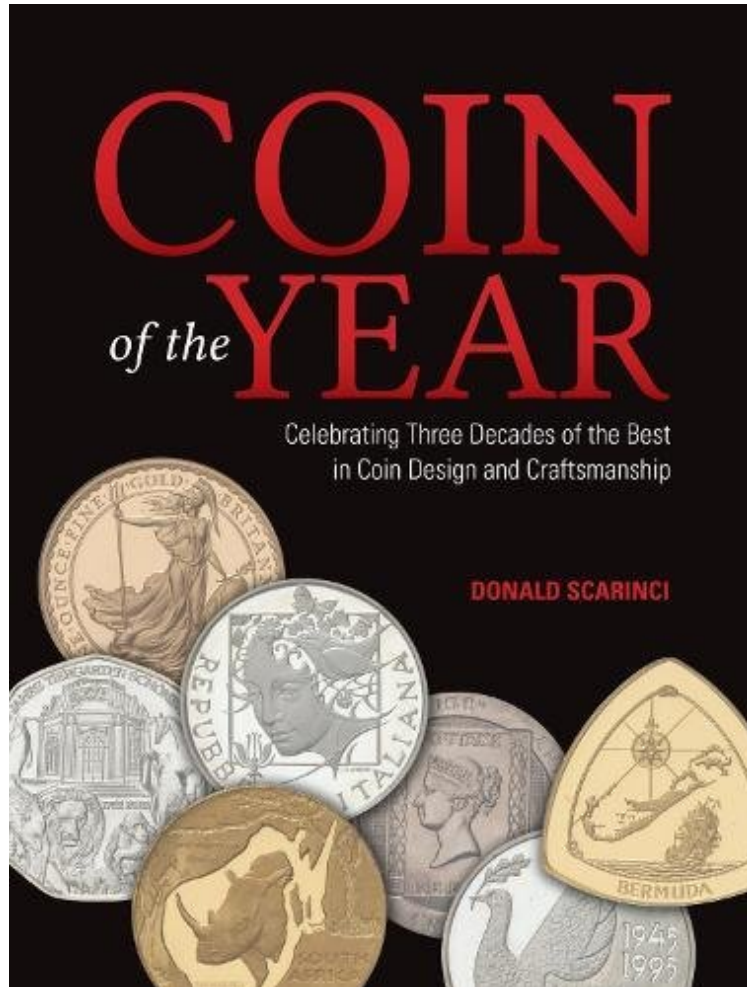

Unfortunately, the approach taken to publish only pictures of the coin with very little explanation as to why these coins are so extraordinary is not very convincing. As a coin collector I would like to learn from the judgement of experts, however, with no explanation given why these coins are so outstanding, it is difficult to follow the judgement of the experts. Indeed, I found some of the coins displayed to be really stunners - no explanation needed. However, many other coins appeared to be only of average design quality, so i could not understand the high rating given. For the next edition of

such a book, I would welcome if some of the coins would be thoroughly discussed and a full explanation given why the coins deserve the distinction given to them. There is no need for completeness here, just an opportunity to follow and to understand the judgement of the expert jury. The author claims in the introduction that the ratings lead to these coins having a higher market value than coins without such a rating. This statement is most definitely not always true.

I bought some of these coins on eBay very close to spot. I was surprised to learn that the market seems to prefer bullion coins to the commemorative variety of coins. I suspect that the minting industry produces too many of these semi numismatic coins to the point where modern numismatics can occasionally be bought at a lower price than regular bullion coins. Hundred years ago, there were fewer people on earth and therefore fewer coins were produced.
