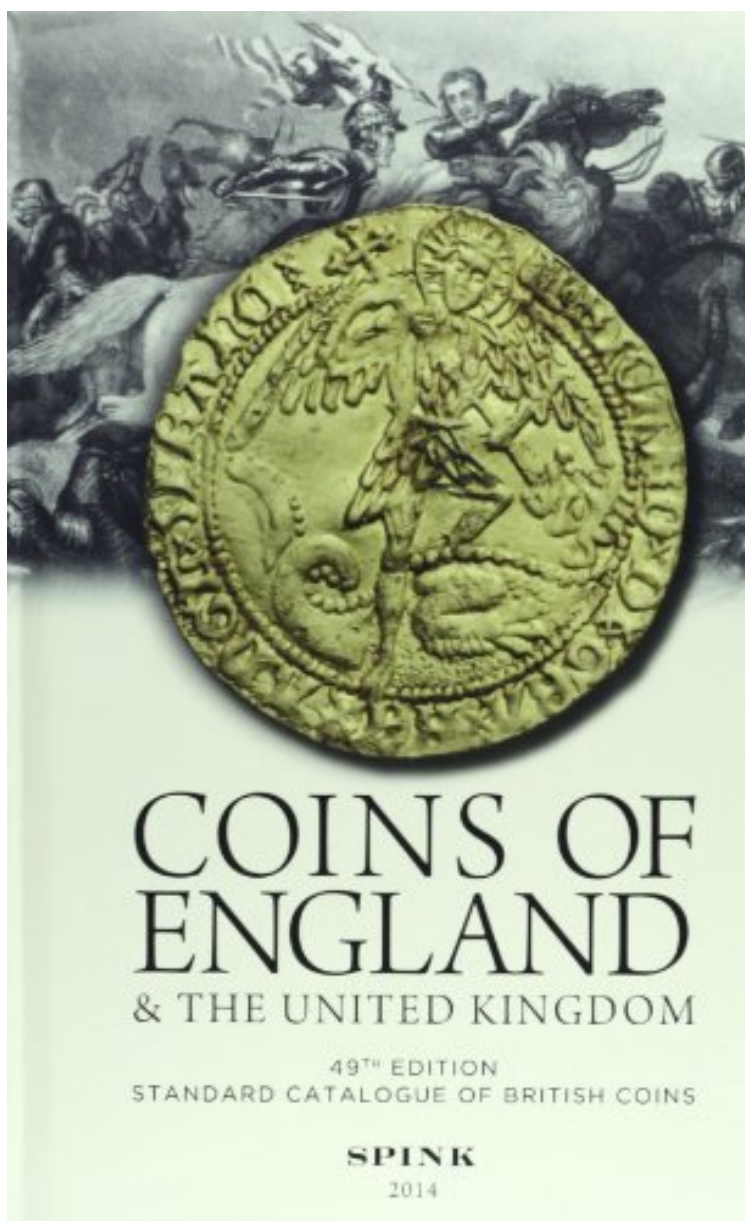

Carping critics may complain that not all coin types are illustrated, but they would want neither the bulk nor the price such completeness would entail. I was particularly pleased to see improved helps distinguishing various bust types of some monarchs. I am unaware how new some of these features are since I do not buy every edition. Quality of illustrations is generally excellent. The tonal quality of some Celtic coins is rather dark, but such pieces are incredibly rare and expensive. Picture upgrades will no doubt come later. The more popular series have been brightened by colorized illustrations. The amount of information is amazing for the price. New to me was a very full section of advertisements from major coin dealers. The decimal series will be dropped out in future issues and going to its own book. The major lack is, of course, the special listing of Irish and Scottish material. At this writing the revised volume covering Coins of Scotland and Ireland has not appeared. It has gone through several editions. I have used several versions of this reference since the Seaby days and find this new effort quite satisfactory.
