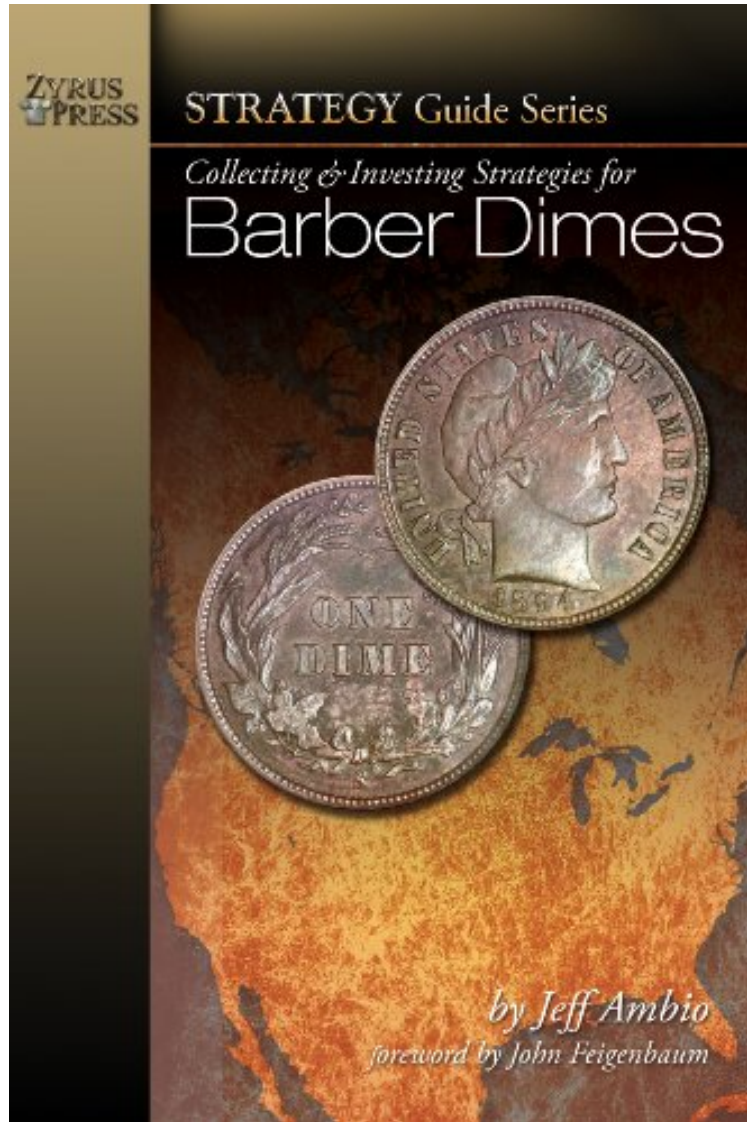

This is a great book for those who want to learn about the strike, luster, surfaces, toning and eye appeal of each of the 74 business strike and 24 proof Barber Dimes as well as the 1894-S branch mint proof.
