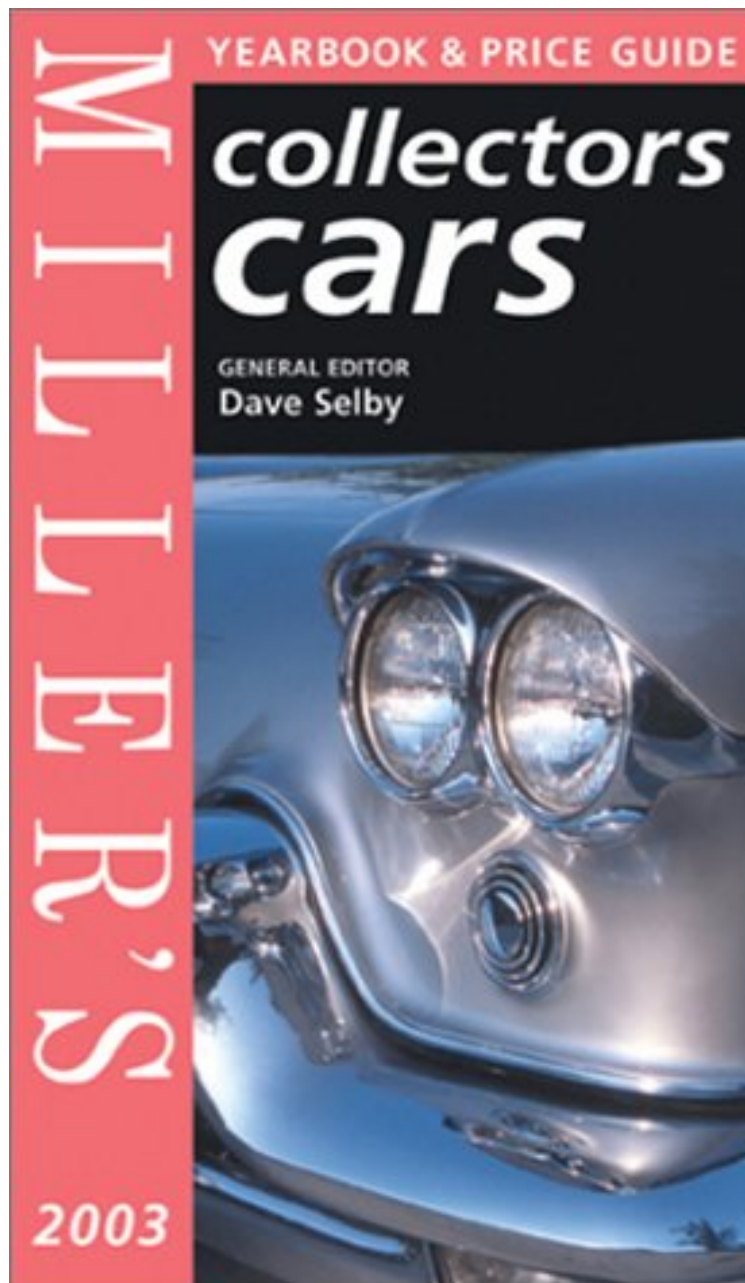

Marques are presented in alphabetical order and are illustrated with captions that describe the car's history, any restoration work carried out and its realized price if sold at auction. The source of each car can be traced by matching the code found at the end of each caption to the key to illustrations. Throughout the guide are features on "Miller's Starter Marques", a useful source of information for those on a budget who are looking for reliable, accessible and affordable, collectable cars. Accompanying most marques is the Miller's price box, which list values of cars throughout decades of manufacture depending on their condition. The "Miller's Compares" feature explains why two cars that look similar can fetch very different prices at auction and the guide also features a directory of car clubs, auctioneers and museums. The yearbook doubles as both a price guide, a portrait of Europe's passions and fashion and a transport of nostalgic delight.
