

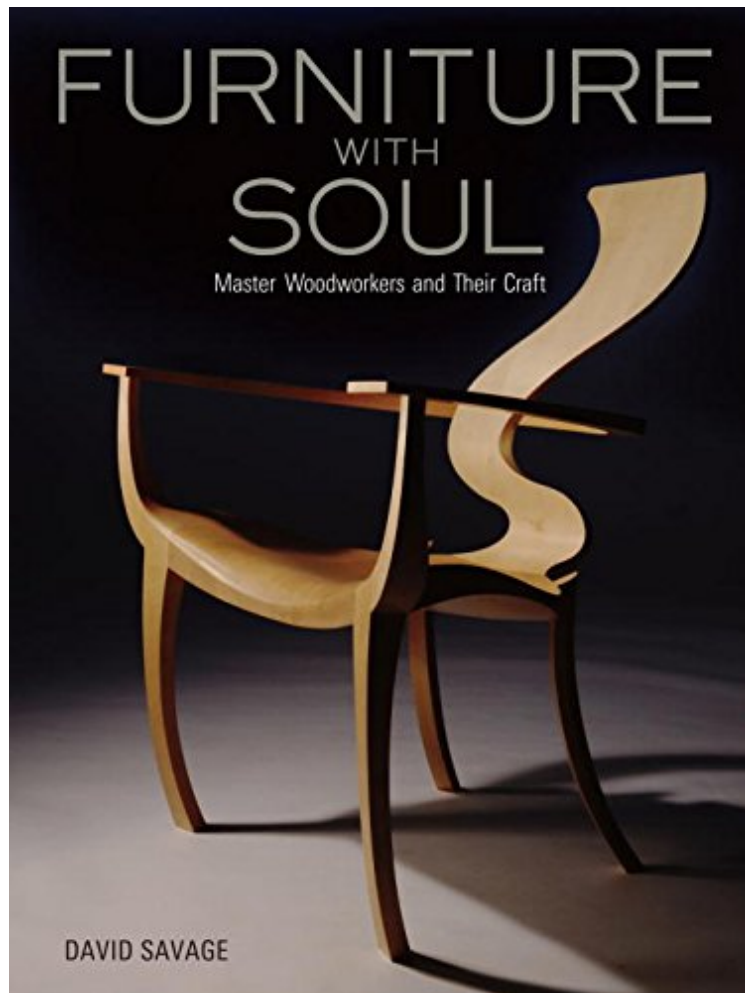

Savage has travelled extensively and spoken to some of the most influential contemporary furniture makers in the USA and the UK.
