

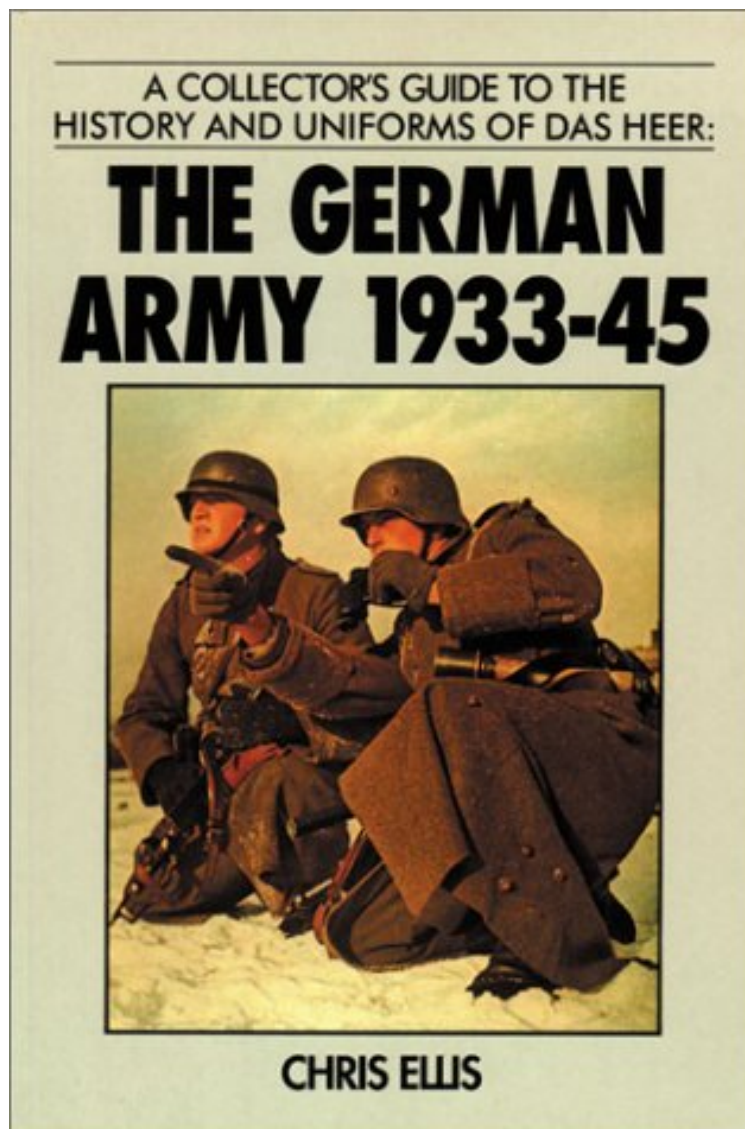

Detailed descriptions of the uniforms and insignia of the German Army are supplemented by sections giving a concise historical background that shows how it fitted in to the Third Reich political system and the events of World War II and similarly concise coverage of organisation and command.
