SnyderI acquired a multiple Harness loom (more than four harnesses) and needed a book to help explore the possibilities of weaving on more than four. Up until that time I had woven on a four harness loom for a few years and was seeing a number of woven patterns that interested me that had been woven on six and eight harnesses.The author, Pierre Ryall, states that most available books on weaving are devoted to American and Scandinavian styles and techniques. Ryall feels that his book is notable for its distinct French Flavor. Ryall is a distinguished weaver, teacher and author whose books have become "bibles" of French weavers.This book is written primarily for experienced weavers - this is NOT a "how to weave" book. Ryall presents patterns for up to 12 harnesses for those so inclined. There is even an entire chapter on how to set up a countermarch loom - and that process is not for the faint hearted, but if a student is interested and wants to explore that avenue, the information is in the book.Information is presented in a clear and concise manner and is very organized. An excellent reference book for the weaver who wants to explore "More than Four".
