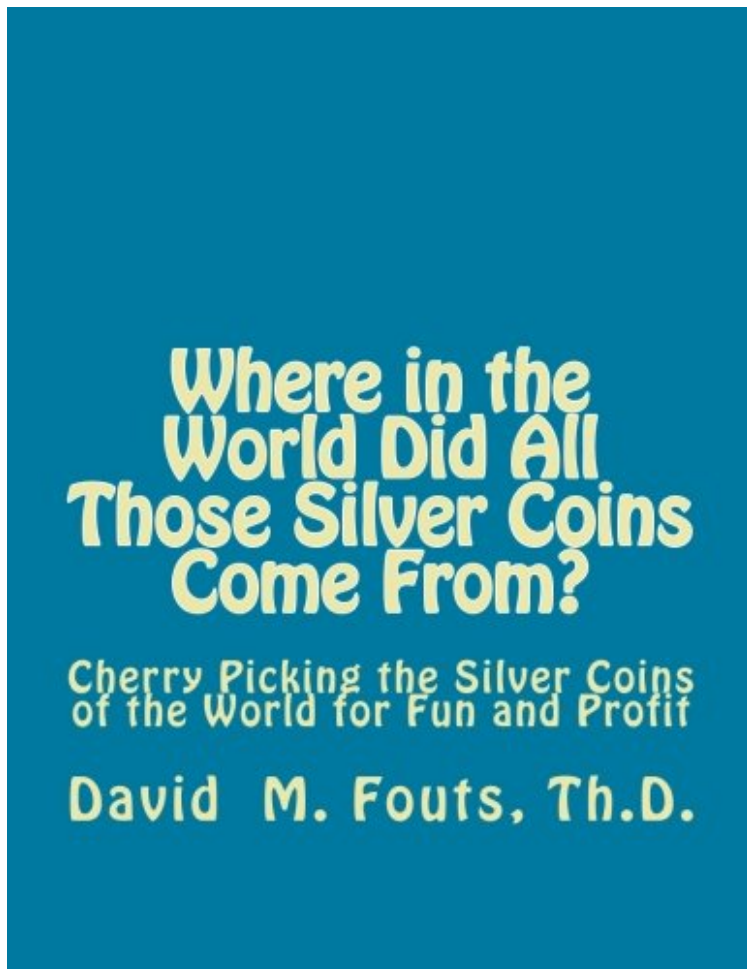

Conversely, those coins which do not have numismatic significance still have value in today's market as silver bullion, and this book provides the tools for the method of determining just how much one can expect to receive when remitting the coins to reputable dealers.
